## Act

Is there something you can do to remind yourself that you have a Frontline?

Do you spend a lot of time in front of a computer? You could change your screensaver image to one that reminds you of the people on your Frontline

You could take a moment to pray as you enter your workplace, reminding yourself you are going in as a disciple of Jesus.

Could you begin to identify "a person of peace " from someone who you see regularly on your frontline?

Others have chosen a particular Christian song that they play at the beginning of each day to remind them that they are about to start another day as a Frontline disciple. This could become a 'theme tune' for life on the Frontline.


Some choose to go to the same newsagent or coffee shop every morning to build a relationship with the people who work there so that they can somehow bless them each day – an encouraging word, a smile, a 'thank you', a compliment.

## What is my Frontline and why does it matter?

Aim: To introduce the idea of the Frontline and to explore why we need to value one another's Frontlines.

Core Text: Matthew 28:16-20

Over the past 3 years we have established the 3 key dimensions for our discipleship...

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As we have "moved out" we have begun to recognise that we we all have a frontlines so what is my frontline?

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Imagine what it might look like in you were:

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Matt 20: 16- 20

*"Then the eleven disciples left for Galilee, going to the mountain where Jesus had told them to go. When they saw him, they worshiped him—but some of them doubted! Jesus came and told his disciples, "I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age."*
