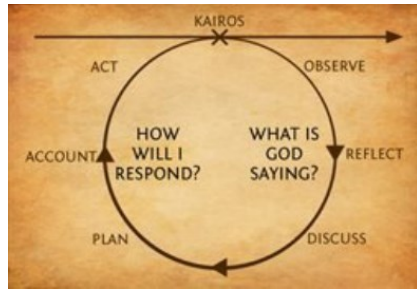
Theme for this evening:

Kairos Circle

Jesus said, “The time has come, the Kingdom of God is near; repent and believe the good news” Mark 1: 15



153 Experiment

Jesus said..., “do you have any fish?” They answered him, “No.” He said to them, “Cast the net on the right side of the boat, and you will find some.” So they cast it, and now they were not able to haul it in, because of the quantity of fish.... 153 of them ... John 21: 5,6,11
